



Y11 Prom 2022-Save the date and Prom expectations

Dear Parent/Carer

With our Y11 students entering their final year with us, we would like to take this opportunity to confirm the details of the Y11 Prom. I am delighted to inform you that the Y11 Prom will take place on **Wednesday 13 July 2022 at Ringwood Hall Hotel**. Further details in relation to timings and payment for tickets will be shared closer to the event.

The Y11 Prom provides an opportunity for students to celebrate their hard work and achievement following the completion of their GCSE exams, along with their peers and their teachers. It is always a very special occasion for all involved and we hope to see as many students from Year 11 as possible in attendance on the night.

The Prom is an invite only event dependent on students meeting set criteria. Any student that fails to meet the expectations listed below will not receive an invite.

- Attendance – Above 96% (absences for medical reasons/COVID-with evidence-will not affect this)
- Average Attitude to Learning in Y11 – 2.4 or lower.
- Punctuality – No more than 15 late marks in Y11
- Revision Sessions – Must have attended at least 25 sessions
- Truancy – No truancy
- Internal Exclusions – No more than 1 internal exclusion throughout the year
- Fixed Term Exclusions – No Fixed Term Exclusions

Information regarding tickets will be sent out after Christmas. We kindly ask parents that they do not make any special purchases for the Prom at this stage as any student who does not meet the criteria outlined above will be unable to attend. School will not be responsible for any monies lost as a result of any student being unable to attend Prom. In addition, whilst we hope there will be no further COVID restrictions next year, the school take no responsibility for any special purchases made for Prom should the event not be able to run. However, money paid towards the cost of the ticket will be refunded if a student does not meet the criteria outlined above.
